



SABC PARTICIPATES IN THE B360 VIRTUAL INTERNSHIP

In April 2021, the Swiss African Business Circle welcomed a student as part of the B360 Virtual Internship pilot program. The B360 Education Partnership developed a program in 2009 that focuses mainly on the sharing of knowledge between European experts, companies and African students. During the program, final year students from partner universities travel to Switzerland to complete internships with Swiss companies, training programs and cultural immersion with host families for a duration of 3-4 months.

The students could not travel to Switzerland for internships this year due to COVID-19 and travel related restrictions, the Virtual Internship pilot program was launched on the 19th of April 2021 to continue facilitating the exchange between Swiss companies and Southern African students, with The Namibia University of Science and Technology being the first institution to be part of such a program.

The SABC believes in working closely with the young, innovating youth and takes pleasure in participating and contributing to this program, as we are currently having a virtual intern in collaboration with B360 Education Partnership. The SABC is pleased to welcome Elizabeth Iita to the team.
